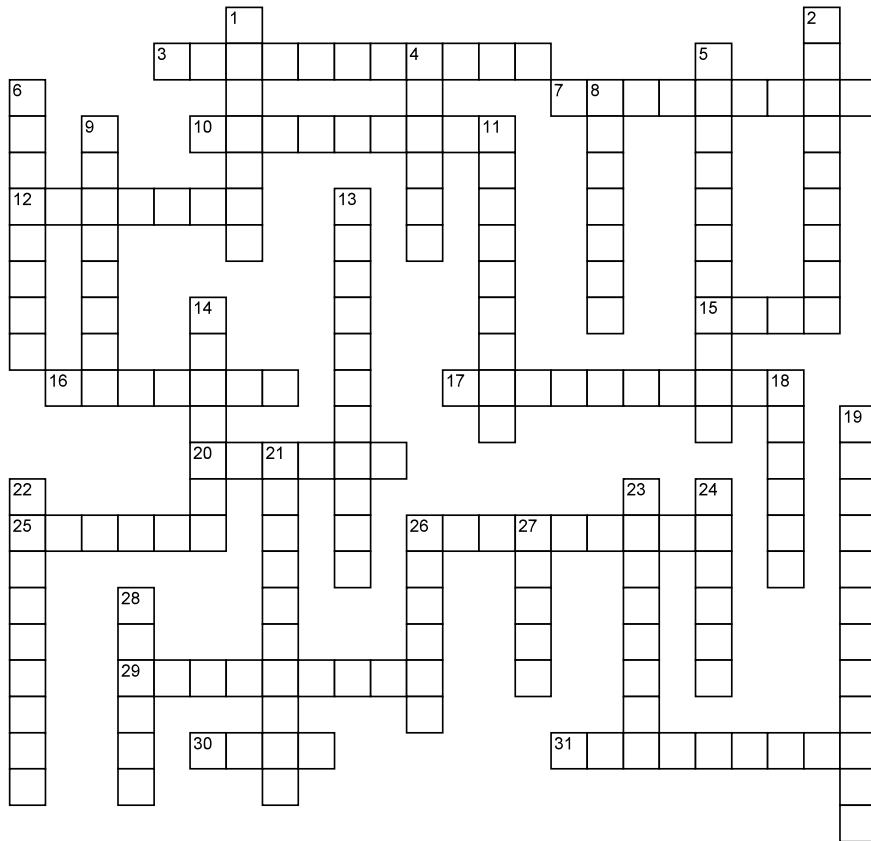

- 7 Jockey whose first Derby win was on Swaps in 1955
- 10 Winning horse of the first Derby
- 12 Third jewel in the Triple Crown
- 15 A Derby Eve race
- 16 His Derby winners included Burgoo King and Bubbling Over
- 17 1943 Triple Crown winner and sire of Count Turf
- 20 His winning percentage was twice Arcaro's
- 25 Man 'o War's famous groom
- 26 First gray to win the Derby
- 29 Winner of the 100th Kentucky classic
- 30 Credited with transforming the Derby into an international event
- 31 Native Kentuckian that rode successive winners His Emminence and Alan-a-Dale

- 1 Crusty gambler that owned the first Derby winner
- 2 Second race of the Crown
- 4 Owner of the legend -- Man 'o War
- 5 2004 Derby winner
- 6 John Galbreath produced his first Derby winner from this farm in 1963
- 8 John E. Madden's famous farm
- 9 Col. E.R. Bradley's place on Old Frankfort Pike
- 11 First Triple Crown winner
- 13 One of the winners Gary Stevens rode
- 14 Farm that produced a long list of Derby winners, including Citation
- 18 Proud owner of Riva Ridge and Secretariat
- 19 Original source of finance that established 14 Down
- 21 Derby winner in 1928, his "son" won in 1943, his "grandson" in 1951

- 22 Brothers John and Henry, that initially leased the land for the Derby track
- 23 Arcaro called this 1948 winner "the best horse" he ever rode
- 24 First filly to win the Derby
- 26 Winner of the first Epsom Derby, his offspring won dozens of the Kentucky version
- 27 Prototype of the Kentucky Derby (Surrey, England)
- 28 Jockey known as "The Master"
