

# Promotional Tour Logic Problem

Aspiring author Bonnie Bluegrass embarked on a whirlwind tour to promote her first publication. For seven consecutive days, she made one appearance each day, in a different city. Three of the appearances were book store signings, two were on radio, and two were TV appearances.

Of the seven stops, one of which was in Louisville, Kentucky, three were scheduled in the morning hours, three in the evening hours, and one in the afternoon, which was the Wednesday appearance.

The Sunday appearance was on radio.

The two TV appearances were scheduled on back-to-back mornings.

She was in St. Louis, Missouri on Thursday, which was not a radio event.

The seven day tour began with an appearance in Toronto, Canada and the final appearance of the tour was a bookstore signing made on Monday evening.

The second radio appearance of the week was made in the morning hours.

The three bookstore signings, which were not on consecutive days, were made in Chicago, Illinois; Hartford, Connecticut; and Norfolk, Virginia; - in that order.

A TV appearance was made on Friday in Atlanta, Georgia
